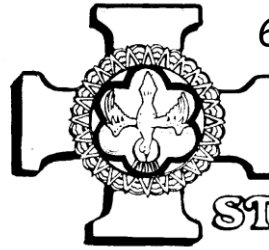


COLLECT OF THE DAY
